### MARINE TARIFF <sup>1</sup>

#### **Vessel Requiring Pilotage**

- ❖ All vessels

\$1.70 per GRT

#### **Pilot Exempt Vessels**

\$1.09 per GRT  
\$2,025.00 minimum charge per visit

#### **Vessel Shifts**

For a vessel requiring pilotage, ships shift charge is 41 cents per GRT

\$4,425.00 minimum charge per shift

#### **Daily Service / Berthage**

- ❖ All vessels while working
- ❖ Lay-up under detention
- ❖ Lay-up by special arrangement (subject to berth availability)
- ❖ Extended Lay Up (> three months)

**Heavy lifts by arrangement and will be subject to surcharges**

### HEAVY LIFT/OVER DIMENSION CARGO

Heavy lift and over dimension cargos will attract a surcharge based on tonnes or cubic metres, whichever is the greater.

Heavy lift permits are required for all single lifts above 30 tonne. Marine fees, berthage and standard wharfage fees also apply.

- ❖ Heavy lift permit minimum charge \$200.00
- ❖ Heavy lift permit (complex) \$250.00 per hour
- ❖ Wharfage \$6.53 per revenue tonne/m<sup>3</sup>
