

## SHIP SECURITY INFORMATION

(Advance notice of crew movements, crew list, visitors and deliveries)

PrimePort Timaru has an obligation under the Maritime Security Act 2004 to control entry of people and goods into "Restricted Areas". This applies to all wharves where international trading vessels are berthed.

PrimePort therefore requests that the following information is provided, prior to a vessel's arrival, to ensure that Port Security is aware of activity on your vessel.

This information will ensure that there is a minimum delay and disruption to ship's activities and cargo operations.

- 2. Crew baggage and Passenger baggage is subject to inspection
- 3. Visitors MUST report to Security
- 4. Agents' cars and some contractors' vehicles are allowed inside the "Restricted Areas" but will be subject to Search and Inspection
- 5. Crew and Passenger Lists are required
- 6. Those not listed can expect delays until verified
